

# **OUR MISSION**

The mission of the Brain Injury Society of Toronto is to enhance the quality of life for people in the City of Toronto, living with the effects of acquired brain injury through education, awareness, support and advocacy.

# **OUR WORK IN 2021**

BIST provides a variety of programs and services, delivered online and by telephone. Our Community Coordinators provide full services to clients, using phone, Internet, and when safe to do so, meet in person one-onone with clients, following all safety guidelines. Once it is safe to return to in-person programming, our members have indicated they prefer hybrid in-person / virtual programming model, which we will implement. Despite the challenges of the Pandemic, in the previous year we significantly increased our services:

# THIS YEAR WE:

- **HELPED** members access practical items including groceries, medication, financial assistance, **technology** (through a technology drive and education program) and other essential supports.
- **INCREASED** online programming including, webinars on personal injury law, gentle hatha yoga, brain injury treatment options, technology and more.
- **CREATED** new programming, including WRAP Mental Health Support Groups for the LGBTQ2S+ community, a Trauma Informed Group, Housing Advocacy Group, and a social drop-in for the South Asian / East Indian Communities living with brain injury.
- **PUBLISHED** a weekly, 'What's Up Wednesday' email newsletter to update members on community resources and information, as well as BIST programming.
- **LAUNCHED**, in partnership with the Brain Injury Association of North Bay & Area, Brain Injury & The Law a province-wide functional support initiative funded by the Ontario Neurotrauma Foundation where supervised social work students assist people living with brain injury dealing with legal matters.

# WHAT YOUR SPONSORSHIP SUPPORTS

# **BIST Programs & Services**

### **COMMUNITY MEETINGS**

BIST hosts monthly meetings featuring a guest speaker, along with time to share stories, information and tips with other people living with ABI and family members. Meetings are open to anyone who is interested and are held on a drop-in basis.

### **CONCUSSION SERIES**

BIST offers this course on taking stock of personal resources and coping skills while dealing with persistent concussion symptoms once per year.

### **BRAIN INJURY SURVIVOR SUPPORT GROUP**

This group is for adults who are living with the effects of a brain injury. It allows a chance for support and connection in a safe and supportive environment. Facilitated by a Social Worker.

### **MEN'S SOCIAL DROP-IN**

This group meets once a month and is an opportunity for men with ABI to connect, share resources and offer support.

### **CAREGIVER PEER SUPPORT GROUP**

This group meets once per month and allows a venue for caregivers of a person with an ABI to connect, share and socialize in a safe space.

### **WOMEN WITH ABI SUPPORT GROUP**

This group is open to women who have sustained a brain injury, providing them with a space to connect and share learning, challenges and experiences and is run by a Social Worker.

### PEER SUPPORT MENTORING

The Peer Mentoring program matches people with ABI or family members with volunteer mentors who can share their experience, offer support and practical tips and information. BIST participates in this program with many other brain injury associations across Ontario, allowing access to a wide variety of mentors with diverse experiences and information.

# SOUTH ASIAN / EAST INDIAN SOCIAL DROP-IN

A social drop-in for members of South Asian & East Indian Communities who live with the effects of brain injury. Discussions take place in Urdu, Hindi, Punjabi, Gujarati and English as per the needs of group members.

### **EXPRESSIVE ART SHOW**

This annual event hosted by BIST brings together BIST artists who showcase their writing, sculpture, painting, photography or crafts. \*Booths at this show are only open to non-profit organizations and BIST Corporate Sponsors, who can purchase a spot for a nominal fee.

# **EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS**

BIST holds educational workshops throughout the year. These workshops are held for professionals, survivors and their families. Past topics have included: • Sleep and ABI • ABI & Sexuality • Returning to Post-Secondary Education Following a Concussion • Self Care and Communication for ABI Caregivers

# WRAP GROUPS (WELLNESS RECOVERY ACTION PLAN) MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT GROUPS

A six-week series run throughout the year for brain injury survivors. Groups include: Trauma Informed, Housing Advocacy and LGBTQ2S+.

## **FUNDING APPLICATIONS**

# ONTARIO TRILLIUM GROW GRANT - COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS COORDINATOR

This grant was received in 2020 and provides three year funding for a Community Connections Coordinator who can assist individuals living with brain injury who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

# CANADIAN WOMEN'S FOUNDATION - VIOLENCE IMPACT COORDINATOR

This grant was received in October 2019 and funds a position to assist victims of violence with ABI to receive financial supports and secure appropriate housing.

### ONTARIO NEUROTRAUMA FOUNDATION - BRAIN INJURY & THE LAW FUNCTIONAL SUPPORT INITIATIVE

An Ontario-wide initiative where supervised social work students assist people with brain injury who are dealing with legal issues. In partnership with the Brain Injury Association and North Bay and Area.

# GOVERNMENT OF CANADA / CANADA SERVICE CORPS / #RISINGYOUTH - TECHNOLOGY TIPS & TRICKS VIDEO SERIES

A series of instructional videos, posted online, on how to access technology such as Google Drive, Zoom etc. geared towards people living with the effects of brain injury.

# BIST LEAP (LEGAL EDUCATIONAL AWARENESS PROJECT)

This grant was received through the Law Foundation of Ontario to develop, organize and deliver inperson and web based resources and education sessions for people with Acquired Brain Injury involved in the criminal justice system. www.abijustice.org
